- Fees and charges: To secure a position in the course, a non-refundable minimum deposit of \$450 is required. This payment confirms the learner's enrolment in the course. The payment structure for the course offers flexibility by allowing learners to distribute the total fees of \$5,150 across ten monthly instalments.
- **Course Duration:** The course will run over a 12 month period. There is a compulsory 100 hours practical workplace experience at work placement/dog training centres located throughout Australia.
- Local Learner: (Melbourne only): Learners are expected to attend up to two compulsory weekends (Saturday and Sunday) per month.
- Distance Learners: Learners are required to attend two compulsory 8-day block training sessions.
- Course Outcomes: Graduates can expect to secure vocational outcomes such as; Professional Dog Trainers/Handlers, Vet Nurses, Dog Walkers/groomers and more.
